Interim Directors' Report

The Group registered a profit before taxation of \in 65,541 for the first six months of 2013 compared to a loss of \in 750,260 for the same period in 2012. The results for the period include unrealised fair value gains of \in 349,170 versus fair value gains of \in 347,735 in the equivalent period last year.

The Group continues to focus on its core businesses of life insurance and health insurance agency complemented by the investment arm, concentrating on growing and developing its direct sales force and diversifying its product range and distribution channels. The implementation of the life company's administrative IT system remains on track with the go live date targeted for early 2014. The new system will position the company for growth and expansion moving forward.

GlobalCapital Life Insurance (GCLI) registered a profit before tax of €504,505 compared to a profit of €297,458 for the same period in 2012. The improved results are driven by a marked improvement in the new business registered as well as continued cost containment.

The Investment Division registered considerable growth in revenue compared to the first six months of 2012. The positive result was a combination of improved productivity, the company offering a wider array of products offered by international reputable principals as well as the market's gradual regained appetite for investment products. Revenues from the Agency business remained in line with the prior period's figures.

On the basis of the Group's updated current and forecast statement of financial position, cash flows and scenarios for raising additional finance should the need arise, the Directors are of the view that the Company and the Group have adequate resources for future operations.

The Directors do not recommend the payment of an interim dividend.

Level 2 collective investment schemes are valued using the realisable net asset value per share of the fund as published by the fund administrator on the Malta Stock Exchange or website of the fund administrator as applicable.

At 30 June 2013 and 31 December 2012, the carrying amounts of financial assets, other than investment in group undertakings, and financial liabilities approximated their fair values, with the exception of financial liabilities emanating from investment contracts with DPF. It is impracticable to determine the fair value of these contracts due to the lack of reliable basis to measure the future discretionary return that is a material feature of these contracts.

The fair value of the bonds issued by the company, admitted to the official list of the Malta Stock Exchange was quoted at €80 at 30 June 2013 (€80 at 31 December 2012).

Notes to the Condensed Financial Statements

- a) This half-yearly report is published pursuant to chapter 5 of the Malta Financial Services Authority Listing Rules and the Prevention of Financial Markets Abuse Act, 2005. The condensed set of consolidated financial statements attached to this report has been extracted from GlobalCapital p.l.c.'s unaudited Group financial statements for the six months ended 30 June 2013, and has been reviewed in terms of ISRE2410 'Review of interim financial information performed by the independent auditor of the entity'.
- b) These condensed consolidated interim financial statements have been prepared in accordance with International Accounting Standard 34 'Interim Financial Reporting'.
- c) The condensed financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention, except for the revaluation of investment properties and financial instruments. The same accounting policies, presentation and methods of computation have been followed in these condensed financial statements as were applied in the preparation of the Group's financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2012. IFRS 13 Fair value measurement, was adopted for the first time during this reporting period as this standard was effective for financial periods commencing 1 January 2013. The standard was adopted to the extent applicable to interim financial reports and did not result additional disclosures to those made in the annual financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2012.
- d) The Group's operations consist of the provision of investments, advisory and insurance broking services in terms of the Investment Services Act, 1994 and the Insurance Intermediaries Act, 2006, the carrying on of long term business of insurance under the Insurance Business Act, 1998, the provision of property management and consultancy services and handling property acquisitions, disposals and development projects. The Group's turnover is primarily generated in and from Malta.
- e) Commitments for capital related expenditure not provided for in these condensed consolidated financial statements amounted to €713,400 as at 30 June 2013 (30 June 2012: €1.032.000)
- f) The net gain on financial instruments recognised in the condensed consolidated statement of comprehensive income for the period ended 30 June 2013 amounted to €349,170 (2012 €34,735).
- g) Earnings per share is based on the net result for the period divided by the weighted average number of ordinary shares in issue during the period. The weighted average number of shares in issue during the period amounted to 13,207,548 shares (2012: 13,207,548).
- h) In the Directors' opinion the Group's portfolio of investment property has not been materially affected during the period ended 30 June 2013.
- i) The impairment charge on goodwill for the six month period ended 30 June 2013 was nil compared to €107,717 for the same period ended 30 June 2012. In accordance with International Financial Reporting Standards goodwill is tested for impairment annually and whenever there is an indication of impairment.
- j) During the period, the Group repurchased 500,000, 5.6% unsecured bonds € 2014/16, from its bondholders. All bonds so purchased by the Group have been cancelled.
